# LAUNDRY SPACE LEASE AGREEMENT

This lease is between WASHCO LAUNDRY EQUIPMENT, INC., a Florida Corporation, 3939 Palm Beach Blvd., P.O. Box 1170, Ft. Myers, FL 33902, hereinafter called Lessee, and Trailer Estates Park & Recreation District, a Special District of the State of Florida, 1903 69<sup>th</sup> Avenue West, Bradenton, FL 34207, hereinafter called Lessor.

In consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, and the duties and obligations set forth, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Lessor hereby leases to the Lessee on a sole and exclusive basis those certain areas, spaces and/or rooms being the laundry facilities of the Lessor's premises located at Trailer Estates, 1903 69<sup>th</sup> Avenue West, Bradenton, Florida 34207, ("Leased Premise") in the laundry room area located north of the post office and approximately 1,135 square feet in size.
2. The Lessee agrees to install at, on, or in the Leased Premises pay-per-use laundry equipment in a number which in the Lessee's sole opinion is sufficient for the use of the tenants at the premises described in paragraph 1. The Lessee agrees to service and keep the machines in good repair at its own cost and expense. Vending prices shall be as determined by Lessee, from time to time. Title to the machines will remain in the Lessee at all times. Lessor agrees that Lessee shall have the right of quiet enjoyment of the demised premises, including unobstructed access and egress to the Leased Premises at all times.
3. The Lessor shall not move or remove, disconnect or tamper with the Lessee's machines, except as provided herein, and Lessor further agrees that it will not permit any other pay-per-use or free or leased common area laundry machines for the use of its tenants on the premises whether the same be owned and operated by the Lessor or others. The Lessor will promptly report any machine malfunction to the Lessee.
4. The Lessor will supply, install and maintain all necessary facilities in the demised premises required for the operation of the said laundry equipment, including electricity, gas, if required, hot and cold water, water disposal, duct work, painting, flooring and lighting and provide daily janitorial service and lint disposal.
5. Lessee will pay rental for said laundry facilities, less any sales, use, or property taxes and/or license or occupational fees, computed on 50% of the gross revenue derived from the operation of said equipment in excess of \$ -0- monthly, per piece of equipment on an accumulative basis, or based on the rate of \$ N/A monthly for each physically occupied apartment.
6. This lease is for a term of seven years from the date hereof and shall not be amended or cancelled except upon mutual written consent of the parties. This lease shall be automatically renewed for a one year period unless either party notifies the other by certified mail, return receipt requested, at least 60 days before the expiration of said initial term or any renewal, of its intent to terminate. There is no restriction on the number of one year renewals permitted under this lease. All terms and conditions of this lease shall apply to the renewed terms of this lease.
7. In the event of default by either party under this agreement, the other party shall notify the defaulting party of the default in writing and the defaulting party shall have thirty (30) days to remedy the default. If not remedied within the thirty day time period, the Agreement may be terminated. Upon termination or expiration of this contract, all Lessee's equipment and possessions shall be removed from the Leased Premises by Lessee within thirty (30) days of termination or expiration, unless agreed to in writing by Lessor. Failure of Lessee to remove such equipment in a timely manner shall result in the equipment being declared abandoned by Lessee and the Lessor may remove the equipment and dispose of the equipment.
8. This lease shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the heirs, assigns, personal representatives and successors of the parties hereto. If any litigation results in connection with this lease, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs from the other party.
9. This lease is entered into by Lessor through its duly authorized agent or owner with full knowledge of the contents hereof and acquiescence thereto by the owner of the demised premises.
10. The Lessor shall have the right to accompany the Lessee's representative when the revenue from the equipment is collected, provided that the collector is not inconvenienced or delayed in any way.
11. This lease is governed under the laws of the State of Florida and venue for any litigation under the lease shall be the courts in and for Manatee County, Florida.

## SECOND AMENDMENT TO LEASE AGREEMENT

**THIS IS A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN TRAILER ESTATES PARK & RECREATION DISTRICT, 6800 Canada Boulevard, Bradenton, Florida 34207 ("OWNER") AND WASHCO LAUNDRY EQUIPMENT, INC., 3939 Palm Beach Boulevard, P.O. Box 1170, Ft. Myers, Florida 33902 ("WASHCO") commencing on May 2, 2021 ("AGREEMENT").**

**WHEREAS,** the OWNER and WASHCO desires to amend the AGREEMENT to move the laundry room to a smaller area ("NEW LAUNDRY ROOM") and allow WASHCO to relocate some of the washers and dryers currently at Trailer Estates to a more productive location outside of the District.

**NOW THEREFORE,** the parties agree to amend the AGREEMENT as follows:

1. Under the portion of the AGREEMENT as to WASHCO'S responsibility as to equipment, this section is amended to read as follows:

- A. **EQUIPMENT:** To supply the laundry room with a minimum of four washers, four dryers and two carts. The laundry room shall be relocated to the NEW LAUNDRY ROOM as shown in the attached Exhibit "A". Upon execution of this Second Amendment by both parties, OWNER shall relocate or provide any necessary plumbing to the NEW LAUNDRY ROOM. WASHCO shall move the laundry machines to the NEW LAUNDRY ROOM within twenty (20) days of being notified of the installation or relocation of plumbing to the NEW LAUNDRY ROOM ("Relocation Period"). WASHCO shall coordinate such move with OWNER. For any laundry machines not relocated to the NEW LAUNDRY ROOM, WASHCO can relocate those laundry machines and equipment to another WASHCO location. Any laundry machines and equipment remaining in the current Laundry Room after The Relocation Period shall be property of OWNER and may be used or disposed of in the sole discretion of OWNER. Similarly, upon expiration of the AGREEMENT, as amended, on May 28, 2026, WASHCO shall have twenty (20) days to remove any WASHCO laundry machines and equipment from the property of OWNER. After the twenty (20) day period to remove laundry machines and equipment, any laundry machines or equipment remaining on OWNER'S property shall be property of OWNER and may be used or disposed of in the sole discretion of OWNER.

2. Section 119.0701(2)(a), Florida Statutes –

Contact information of the public agency's custodian of public records

Public Records: Vendor must comply with public records law:

- A. Keep and maintain public records required by the District to perform the service.
- B. Upon request from the District, provide the District with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided in this chapter or as otherwise provided by law.
- C. Ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the contract term and following completion of the contract if the Vendor does not transfer the records to the District.
- D. Vendor shall upon completion of the AGREEMENT, transfer at no cost, to the District all public records in possession of the Vendor or keep and maintain public records required by the District to perform the service. If the Vendor transfers all public records to the District upon completion of the AGREEMENT, the Vendor shall destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. If the Vendor keeps and maintains public records upon the completion of the contract, the Vendor shall meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records. All records stored electronically must be provided to the District upon request from the District's custodian of public records, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of the District.
- E. Vendor acknowledges that all information contained relating to the Agreement are public records, as defined in Chapter 119. "Public Records" of the Florida Statutes. No information should be labeled confidential unless exempted under said laws.
