

## AGREEMENT No. 20-R074950SB

# TREE TRIMMING SERVICES

between

MANATEE COUNTY (COUNTY)

and

(CONTRACTOR)

- 1. All Work must be supervised by an ISA Certified Arborist. The ISA Certified Arborist must be on-site during performed services.
- 2. Trim all trees growing in the County right of way, including trees on private property of which branches or limbs are growing over the County right of way. No matter the source, the material growing too low over the right of way or sidewalk shall be trimmed as follows:
  - (a) Contractor shall trim trees at least to the minimum vertical clearance height over roadways of 18 feet.
  - (b) Contractor shall trim trees to the minimum vertical clearance height over sidewalks of 10 feet with a maximum vertical clearance of 12 feet.
  - (c) Horizontal clearance shall be flush and even with the back (residential) side of the sidewalk when a sidewalk is present or to the back of the curb if no sidewalk is present.
- 3. Provide complete visibility by trimming around traffic lights, street signs, flashing signals, traffic signs and any other signage.
- 4. Trim all around streetlights up to three (3) feet above and behind the light. Lights shall have a clearance of 45-degree angle from light to ground.
- 5. Provide traffic management for the work zone, which is to include signage and flagging, as needed. Contractor or employee must carry a certified FDOT Intermediate MOT Contractor Certification. The individual with the certification must be on-site during the services.
- 6. Ensure to present performance standards for the care and management of trees per ANSI A300 Standards, Part 1: Pruning Standards
- 7. Ensure the quality of workmanship meets or exceeds ANSI A300 Standards, Part 1: Pruning Standards.
- 8. Remove dead wood with a diameter of two (2) or more inches if the wood has the potential to fall into or onto a roadway or sidewalk.

### 1.04 COUNTY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. The County reserves the right to add or remove services and locations as necessary throughout the term of the Agreement.
- 2. Provide maps of tree trimming projects each year.

### 1.05 ACCESSIBILITY

Contractor shall ensure all of its electronic information, documents, applications, reports, and deliverables required under the Agreement are in a format that meets the requirements of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act and best practices (W3C WCAG 2).

Where not fully compliant with these requirements and best practices, Contractor shall provide clear points of contact for each document and information technology to direct users in how to obtain alternate formats. Further, Contractor shall develop accommodation strategies for those non-compliant resources and implement strategies to resolve the discrepancies.
